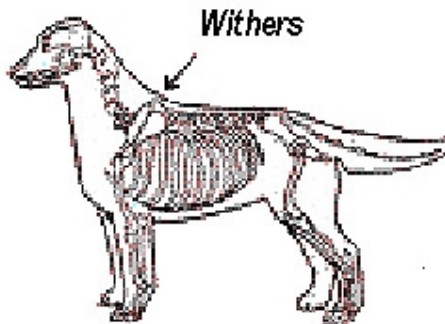
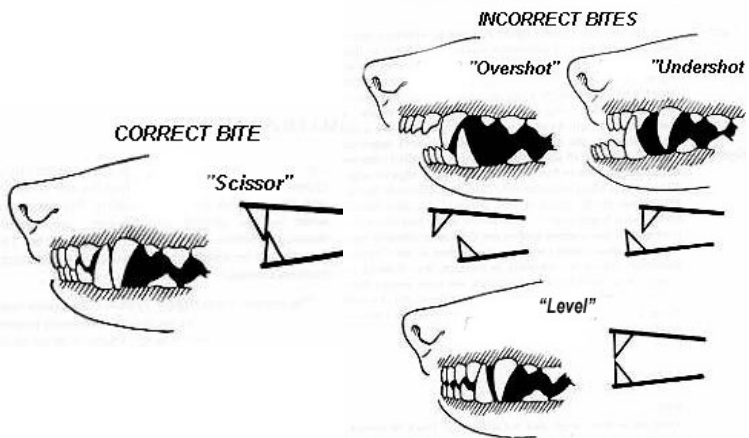


Illustration 2: Correct Scissors Bite vs. Incorrect Bites
